



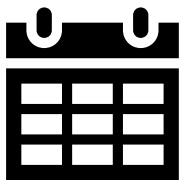

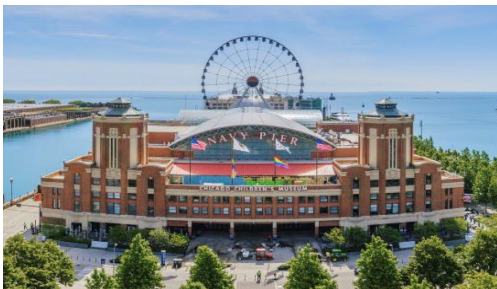

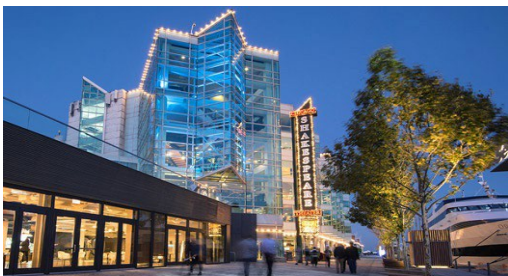
I will double check my ticket

Driving to Chicago Shakespeare Theater



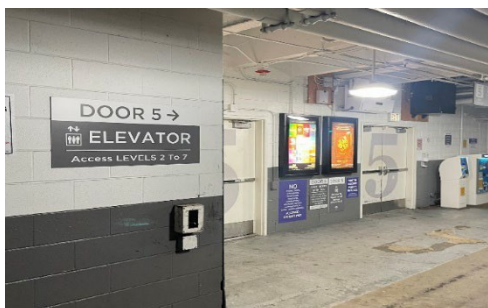
When I arrive to the pier, I will follow the signs that say **“Navy Pier Parking”**



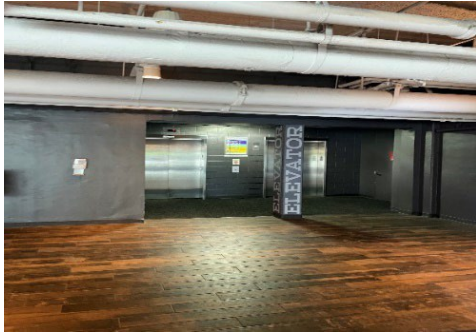
I will follow the sign that says **“Entrance 1”**



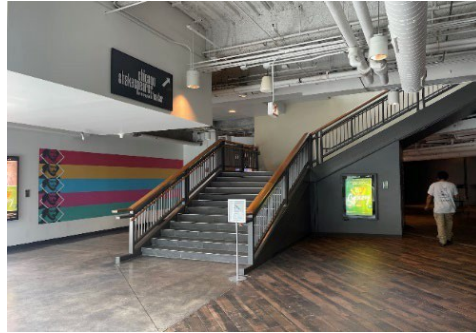
I will turn into the door with the **“Chicago Shakespeare Parking”** sign



I will park and find the double doors that say **“Door 5”**



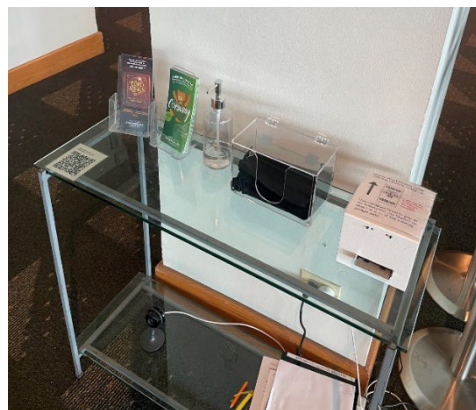
I can take the **elevator** to Level 2



I can also take the **stairs** to Level 2



I will see a Chicago Shakespeare **staff member** wearing **silver name badge** and **radio** who will direct me into the theater



I will **validate** my parking so I can get \$22 parking.

I will insert my parking ticket into the **white box** so it will print a **third barcode** in the middle of my parking ticket

CTA to Chicago Shakespeare Theater



I can take the train to the theater. The nearest train station is the **Grand Red Line**. I can transfer to a bus to get go the rest of the way

The nearest buses to the Grand stop that will take me to the theater are:

#65 Grand bus

#66 Chicago bus

#29 State bus

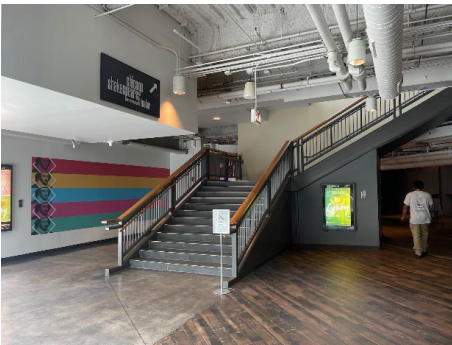
I can stay on the bus to the end of the line which is the Navy Pier Terminal



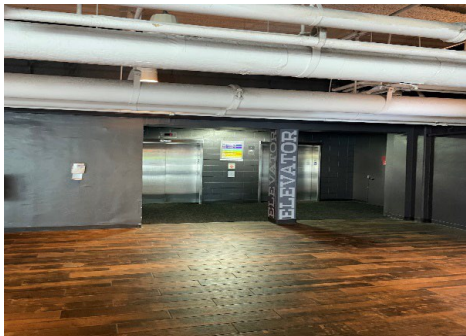
I will get off the bus and go to the front of the pier



If I want to walk outside, I can walk along the pedestrian sidewalk with the water on my right side until I see the large **Shakespeare Sign**. Enter through the glass doors directly below.



I can take the **stairs** to Level 2.



Or I can take the **elevator** to Level 2.



I will see a staff member wearing **all black clothing** and a **radio** who will direct me into the theater.

I am dropped off at Chicago Shakespeare Theater



If I am being dropped off or I am taking a taxi or rideshare, I should ask them to follow the signs for “**Navy Pier Parking**”



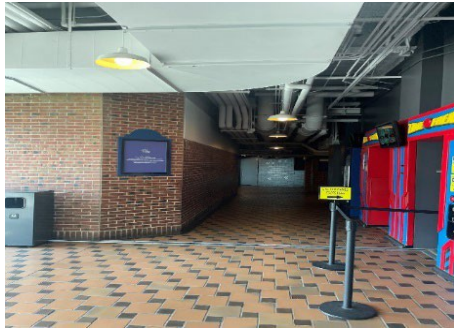
I can ask them to pull into “**Entrance 1**” about halfway down the Pier



I can get out at the curve of the turnaround. I will go through the **glass** doors

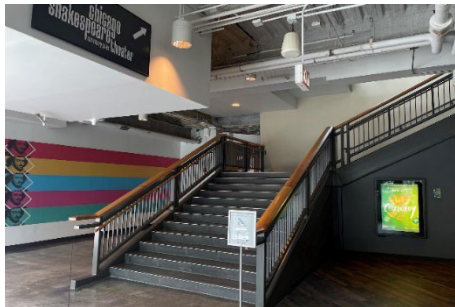


I will follow the hallway towards Billy Goat Tavern and turn **right**



I will walk past the Maze and follow the hallway to the **left**.

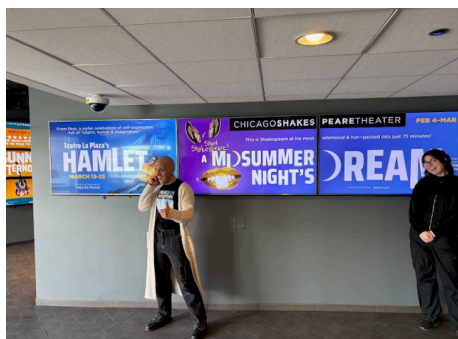
I will continue down the hallway with the stores on my right and the windows on my left



I will see a **large staircase** that can take me to Level 2



Or I can use the **elevators** to my **right** that can also take me to Level 2



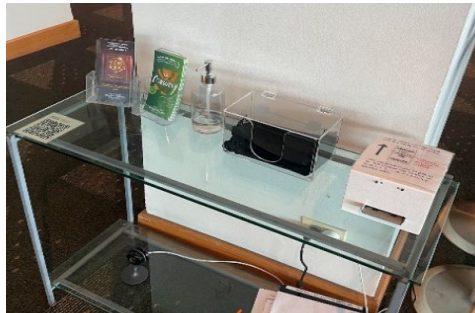
I will see a theater staff member wearing **all black clothing** and a **radio** who will direct me into the theater



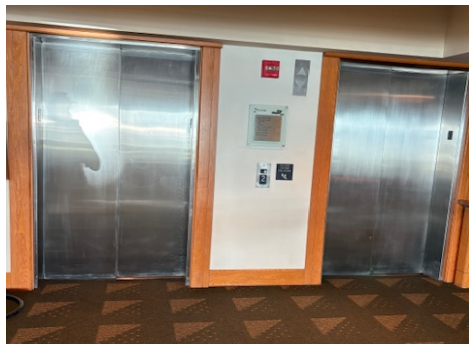
If I need to pick up my ticket, an assisted listening device, sensory tools, large print programs or need to move my seat; I will go to the right to talk to the box office.



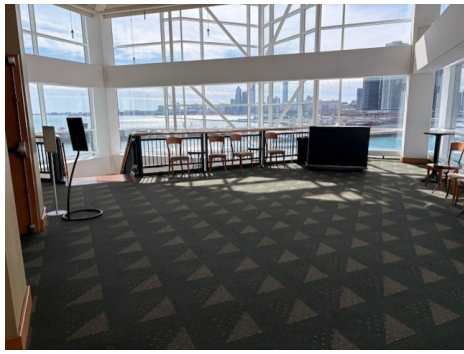
After I pick up my ticket or pull it up on my phone, a staff member will scan the barcode on my ticket.



If I drove to the pier, I will validate my parking ticket to get discounted parking.



I will use the **elevator** to go to the **6th floor**. I will turn **right** when I get off the elevators



I can sit in the lobby or buy something from concessions



Or I can use the restroom.



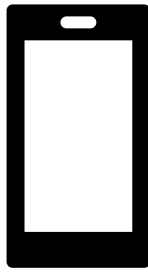
Once the doors to the seating open, I can take my seat.
A volunteer will hand me a program and ask me where my seat is.



I will look at the large letters on the side of the aisle to find my row.



I will look on the top of the back of seats to find my seat number.



If I have a cellphone on me, I will turn it off.



At any point during the performance, I can watch the show from the lobby or step outside



At the end of the show, I can clap for the actors, once they leave the stage I can stand up and walk out



When I am ready, I can return any items I borrowed and take the elevator to floor 2 and exit the main lobby doors I entered through
