## LITTLE VILLAGE

"La Villita" offers a slice of Mexican-American life in Chicago, known as the Quinceañera Capital of the Midwest. Global grocery stores, bakeries, retail locations, and vibrant murals fill its thriving business district. **PIOTROWSKI PARK** was named after one of its lifelong neighborhood residents.

## **CHINATOWN**

PING TOM MEMORIAL PARK, on the south bank of the Chicago River, offers spectacular skyline views from Chicago's century-old Chinatown. The central district evokes its deep heritage, with statues, pagodas, ornate archways, family-owned restaurants, and storefronts.

## **ENGLEWOOD**

With over 70,000 residents and many highly engaged community organizations, Englewood is home to ambitious business incubators that support small business owners and entrepreneurs. The green space of **OGDEN PARK** offers a variety of recreational, educational, and social services.

## **WEST PULLMAN**

Home to **WEST PULLMAN PARK**, this historic community on the far South Side of Chicago has a strong network of block clubs, churches, and community groups, including the Kroc Community Center—the largest of its kind in Illinois.
